

## 2025 Combine Derby Rules

1. Battery must be secured and covered and relocated into the hopper of the machine. Fuel tank also needs to be relocated into the hopper of the machine. Factory fuel tanks must have a hole drilled through the bottom and visible for inspection.
2. No fluid filled, or foam filled tires allowed.
3. Platform must have reel, sickle, and snouts removed. Corn heads must have snouts and row units removed.
4. Head should be rigid mounted 18-21" off the ground.
5. Heads can be braced with a maximum of 4X4 square tubing at 45 degrees from the feeder house but not to exceed the outside of the front tires. NO EXCEPTIONS!
6. Combine ladder, unloading auger, chopper, and cab glass must be removed.
7. Hydrostatic drives are allowed
8. Gas or Diesel engines allowed
9. Cab can have any modifications to the cab for safety. Minimum requirements for cab are the following:
  10. Safety bar added to driver's door and reinforcement bar across the front of the cab even with the top of the steering collum.
  11. Steering lines can be rerouted to prevent damage
  12. All drivers will be required to wear a 3-point seat belt minimum. Helmets, gloves, ad eye protection are required.
  13. All seats are required to be bolted through the cab frame rails
  14. All drivers are responsible for removing their equipment after the demolition derby is complete.
  15. All derby combines, and equipment must be removed form the Warren county fair grounds following the demolition derby. Payouts will be at the pit entrance and will only be paid to the driver when the machine is loaded on the trailer and at the pit entrance ready to leave. It shall be the sole responsibility of the combine driver to remove the combine and equipment from the arena and grounds or to make arrangements for it with the derby committee. Any and all combines, equipment, and other property remaining on the grounds the day after the derby shall become the property of the Warren County Fair, and shall be disposed of and/or destroyed in the sole and absolute discretion of the Warren county fair, notwithstanding the fairs ownership of the property, the driver of said combine and related equipment shall remain liable for any and all costs and expensed relating to the disposition and /or destruction of said property, and the Warren county fair shall not be liable for any costs, expenses, or damages whatsoever relating to the disposition and/or destruction of said property.
16. All decisions made by the Fair Superintendents are final.
