

Combine Derby Rules

Rules:

1. Battery must be secured and covered and relocated into the hopper of the machine. Fuel tank also needs to be relocated into the hopper of the machine. Factory fuel tanks must have hole drilled through bottom.
2. No fluid is allowed in the tires.
3. Platform must have reel, sickle, and snouts removed • Corn head must have snouts and row units removed
4. Head should be rigid mounted 18 – 21 inches off the ground.
Heads can be braced with a maximum of 4 x 4 square tubing at 45° from feeder house but not to exceed the outside of the front tires. (NO Exceptions!)
5. Combine ladder, unload auger, chopper, and cab glass must be removed
6. Hydrostatic drives are allowed.
7. Diesel or gas combines are allowed.
8. Drivers can do anything to the driver's cab to make it safer for the driver. Safety bars must be added to drivers door side of cab for drivers protection
9. Steering lines can be re-routed to prevent damage.
10. All drivers will be required to wear 3 point seat belt minimum, helmets and eye protection.
11. All drivers will be required to remove their equipment after the demolition derby is complete.
12. All derby combines, and equipment must be removed from the Warren County fairgrounds following the demolition derby. Payouts will be at the pit entrance and will only be paid to the driver when machine is loaded on the trailer and at the pit entrance ready to leave. It shall be the sole responsibility of the combine driver to remove the combine and equipment from the arena and grounds or to make arrangements for it with the derby committee. Any and all combines, equipment, and other property remaining on the grounds the day after the derby shall become the property of the warren county fair, and shall be disposed of and/or destroyed in the sole and absolute discretion of the warren county fair Notwithstanding the fairs ownership of the property, the driver of said combine and related equipment shall remain liable for any and all costs and expenses relating to the disposition and /or destruction of said property, and the warren county fair shall not be liable for any costs, expenses, or damages whatsoever relating to the disposition and/or destruction of said property.
13. All decisions made by the Fair Superintendents are final.
