

Cattle Entry/Show Rules*

version #1 dated June 10, 2020

Entries:

- o Entries will be taken June 15, 16, 17 from Noon to 7 PM.
- o Entry forms, Warren County Produced forms, 4-H Drug Affidavit will be available at the time of entries.
- Warren County Fairgrounds—Grandstand Ticket Office—stay in your vehicle to properly social distance only getting out to come to the window.
- o 2020 Fair book rules still apply.
- o Fair books cannot be shared. Fair book is available online or can be purchased for \$5 at the grounds.
- o Entry fees are posted in the Fair book on page 5. (Entry Fees are non-refundable if guidelines shut down large gatherings at the end of July)
- o You will be asked at entry time how many market beef you would like to sell if an auction is available.
- Any 4-H/FFA rules regarding YQCA, animal ID in 4-H online, etc. must be followed.
- o No Open Class Livestock.
- Breeding Beef--Arrival time for vet check and check-in is Friday, July 24th from 6 AM to 7 AM
- Breeding Beef—Demonstration by Tracy Cofflin at 8:30 AM Friday on how to "Blow and Show" in Barn 1
- Market Beef--Arrival time for vet check and weigh-in is Saturday, July 25th from 6 AM to 7 AM
 - o Tents (no sides) can be set up between barns 1 & 2 and 2 & 3. No tents on south side of barn #1.
 - Tents (no sides) can be put up the day of show after 5 AM.
 - o Papers & Tattoos will be checked at check -in.
 - o Barn 1 will be unlocked Friday 6:00 AM. All cattle and exhibitors will use Barn 1.
 - o Bedding will be provided in Barn 1.
 - o No exhibitors on the grounds prior to 5 AM on day of show.
 - o NO showing out of trailers.
 - o NO stalling of cattle the night before the show. This includes tack and fans the night before the show.
 - Vet will inspect all Breeding and Market Beef <u>before</u> unloading.
 - Market Beef will be weighed immediately following vet inspection as they are unloaded off the trailer.
 - Breeding Beef will be checked in immediately following vet inspection as they are unloaded off the trailer.
 - o All Cattle should be spaced 6 feet apart by family group. Superintendents will be advising.
 - o Forms due at check-in:

- 4-H Drug Affidavits
- Warren County Produced forms
- Purebred registration papers if applicable
 - ✓ see pages 40 to 44 of the Fair book for registration paperwork requirements.
- Stalling:
 - o Superintendents will oversee stalling to maintain social distancing between family groups.
 - o Cattle should be spread 6' apart unless there is a family group or families that have been together.
- Breeding Beef Show will be held Friday, July 24th beginning at 10 AM.
- Market Beef Show will be held Saturday, July 25th beginning at 10 AM.
 - o This will be a BLOW AND GO show.
 - o Leave all adhesives/hairspray/after shaves/mousse at home. No coloring.
 - o Class size will be held to maximum of _____ for social distancing.
 - o Warren County Produced Show will be held.
 - o Trophies, banners, ribbons, and premiums will be awarded.
 - o Wash racks will be available
 - o 4H/FFA t-shirt rule applies for the show.
 - o There will be no show programs printed. Show programs will be posted for all to follow.
 - o QR codes or other means of communication will be provided.
 - Depending on CDC guidelines you may be required to wear a mask for the show. BE PREPARED. Take
 personal responsibility. IF masks are required and you do not have one, you will not be allowed to show.
 - o At all times, practice social distancing.
 - o Please completely pickup and clean up your area before leaving after the show.
