

Statement from Wasatch County Parks and Recreation addressing masks at the
2021 Wasatch County Fair, Rodeo and Derby

According to the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), current data suggest the risk of transmission of SARS-CoV-2 in outdoor settings is minimal. In general, fully vaccinated people do not need to wear a mask outdoors. Fully vaccinated people might choose to wear a mask in crowded outdoor settings if they or someone in their household is immunocompromised.

Therefore, Wasatch County Parks and Recreation in consultation with the Wasatch County Health Department recommends that unvaccinated and immunocompromised individuals wear masks at county fair events, but masks will not be required. We also request that anyone with Covid19 symptoms not attend. We will have masks available at the ticket gates and information booth at the country market.
