

**Guidelines for
WASHINGTON COUNTY FAIR SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

1. Be a U.S. citizen.
2. Submit a one-page essay on the impact the Fair has had on you.
3. Have participated in the Washington County Fair.
4. Furnish a letter of recommendation from a teacher or principal.
5. Provide college entrance exam scores and copy of high school transcript.
6. Must be a high school graduate and plan to attend an accredited school of higher education or professional training within 5 years.
7. After enrolling, proof of enrollment must be sent to the Fair Association and funds will be paid directly to school.
8. The application along with all required attachments must be complete to be considered for this scholarship.
