

# SINGLE FRYER RABBIT SHOW

Judging: Wednesday, September 14, 2022 following the JLA Rabbit Show

JUDGE: Michael Franke

1. Entry deadline is August 7, 2022 and the entry fee is \$3.00.
2. Exhibitor may enter one single fryer. **Exhibitors are required to bring in donations and or participate in the drive thru fundraiser if participating in the show.**
3. This is a separate class from the market rabbits and will not be sold at the Junior Livestock Sale.
4. AWARDS: Premium money and number of places will be determined according to the dollar amount of donations received. The Junior Livestock Division is not responsible for premium money in this class.

Reserve Champion Single Fryer belt buckle  
Ribbons will be awarded to top 10 places

5. This shall be a separate entry. Market rabbits will not be used in this class.
6. Exhibitor may bring only one alternate fryer for this class.
7. Single fryers will not be over 75 days of age with a weight range min. 3 ½ and max. 5 ½ lbs.
8. All rabbits exhibited will not leave the fairgrounds. One hour after the conclusion of the rabbit judging, all cages will be zip tied and will remain zip tied for the duration of the fair. They will only be cut by authorized committee member(s). All rabbits in those pens will be sent to the possessor. No carcasses will be returned to exhibitors. JLA sale rabbits are property of the buyer, and their resale value (currently \$5 each) will be credited to the buyer of the pen. The value of any other rabbits in the pens will be paid directly to the exhibitor, either by separate check (non-sale exhibitors) or included with the JLA check for sale exhibitors. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have any bunnies they want to send for resale in their pen by the one-hour deadline. **Alternates will need to be removed from the meat pen cage upon completion of the show. Once the pens are zip tied, the extras still in cage will be processed.**
9. All Junior Market Rabbit Show rules will apply unless otherwise stated.
10. Sift for this class will be done with the sifting of the market pen of rabbits.
11. Judging will follow the meat pen class. Single fryer rabbits must be brought to and from the show table by the exhibitor or any other youth entered in the Rabbit Show.

## **RULES FOR ALL EXHIBITORS WANTING TO EXHIBIT IN THE SINGLE FRYER RABBIT SHOW**

**- HIGH SCHOOL AGE (9TH - 12TH) MUST BRING IN A MINIMUM OF \$100 IN DONATIONS.**

**- GRADES 3 - 8 MUST BRING IN A MINIMUM OF \$50 IN DONATIONS.**

Donations can be obtained by doing any of the following:

- bringing in monetary donations adding up to the amount required for your age.

OR

- selling drive-thru fundraiser tickets

(20 tickets for High School and 10 tickets for 3<sup>rd</sup> thru 8<sup>th</sup> grade)

- OR a combination of selling drive-thru tickets and monetary donations.

- PAY THE \$3.00 ENTRY FEE AT TAG IN

**Tickets will be given to all exhibitors at tag in.**
