**RIDERS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO THROW CANDY FROM FLOATS.**

## WASHINGTON COUNTY FAIR PARADE AGREEMENT

By entering or participating in the Washington County Fair Parade you hereby agree to abide by the following rules without fail:

1. Parade Coordinator has absolute and final discretion over all entries' entrance into the parade.
2. No alcohol may be consumed on parade entries
3. No underage person may operate a parade entry. All applicable state laws apply.
4. No offensive wordage or music may be used on a parade entry. Parade coordinator will have final determination as to what is offensive.
5. All parade entries must be of sound construction and operability.
6. No litter or debris may come from parade entry.
7. All occupants riding on a parade entry must be secured in a safe manner while the entry is in motion.
8. All participants are liable for any damage caused by their entry in the parade. Participants, by their mere participation in the parade agree to hold harmless Washington County Fair, Washington County and all parade officials and organization officers from any and all liability regarding any accident or injury while in transit to the parade, during the parade or returning home after the parade, this includes, but is not limited to, items thrown from parade entries.
