

LIVESTOCK EXHIBITOR CAMPING REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- A campground is available for use by registered Washington County Fair Livestock Exhibitors only. Ensure that you are a registered livestock exhibitor with Washington County Open Class, Washington County 4-H or a Washington County FFA school program before registering for a camp site.
- Cost is \$30 per night plus transient lodging tax for a 20' x 20' space and \$50 per night per site plus transient lodging tax for a 20' x 40' site.
- The number of sites available is limited. Once they are sold out camping reservations will end. If your application is accepted and paid for, a site is guaranteed.
- Specific sites are not assigned. On move-in day sites selection is a first come, first serve basis for the size of site you selected.
- Dry camping, no utilities are available.
- Showers are available for use in the Cloverleaf Building.
- Portable Restrooms and Handwashing Sinks will be provided in the campground.
- Advanced registration, advanced credit card payment, and acceptance of the rules of the campground are required.
- Registration and rules can be found on the Fair website
- Anyone found violating the campground rules may be expelled from the campground and may not be allowed to participate at the Fair in the future. Fees paid will not be refunded.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR LIVESTOCK EXHIBITOR CAMPING REGISTRATION

- Verify you have Adobe Reader on your computer or device. This software or app must be loaded on your computer or device in order to submit the camping form. If you do not have Adobe Reader, download the software and/or app. Both are free. To download Adobe Reader, go to <https://get.adobe.com/reader/>
- Once you have downloaded and installed Adobe Reader, download the Livestock Exhibitor Camping Registration Form. **Save it to your computer or device before filling out the form.** You will be prompted to choose a location on your computer or device to save the form to.
- After you have saved the form to your computer or device, fill out all the required fields, digitally sign, and click save.
- Once the form is saved with all of your information and signature, click submit. You will not be able to submit if all the required fields are not filled out, if the form has not been digitally signed, or if you have not saved to your computer or device.
- After you click submit your camping form will be sent to the Fair office. You will receive a confirmation notice within one (1) business day. If you do not receive a confirmation, please call the Fair Office 503-648-1416.
- The confirmation e-mail will include instructions on how to pay for your site. Only credit card payments will be accepted.
