

LIVESTOCK EXHIBITOR CAMPING INFORMATION

1. A campground is available for use by registered Washington County Fair Livestock Exhibitors only. Ensure that you are a registered livestock exhibitor with Washington County Open Class, Washington County 4-H or a Washington County FFA school program before registering for a camp site.
2. The number of sites available is limited. Once they are sold out, camping reservations will end. Site is only guaranteed after application approval and payment.
3. Specific sites are not assigned. On move-in day, **site selection is a first come first serve basis** for the size of site you selected.
4. Dry camping, no utilities are available.
5. Rental Showers, Portable Restrooms and Handwashing Sinks will be provided in the campground.

PAYMENT AND REGISTRATION

Payment and Registration are required in Advance

20' x 20' \$30 per night plus transient lodging tax (**\$34.05**)

25'x x 40' \$50 per night per site plus transient lodging tax (**\$56.75**)

- Campground rules can be found on the application - **acceptance of the rules of the campground are required.**
- Anyone found violating the campground rules may be expelled from the campground and may not be allowed to participate at the Fair in the future. Fees paid will not be refunded.
- Site Map will be available a week before the Fair.

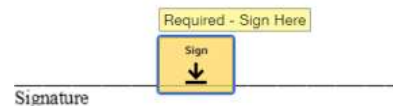
