CAMPGROUND RULES

- Only registered Washington County Fair Livestock Exhibitors may stay or visit the Livestock Exhibitor Campground. Guests are strictly prohibited.
- All camping must fit within the designated space size purchased. All camping will be in designated sites only. Only occupy the camp spot assigned to you.
- Do not block fire lanes.
- All sites are dry – No Electrical, No Water, No Sewer
- There is a maximum of eight campers allowed per site.
- All campers under 18 must have an adult chaperone, at least 25 years of age, who will assume responsibility for the youth's conduct and health and must be with them in the campsite at all times, including overnight.
- No person shall consume, or have in his or her possession, any controlled substance or alcoholic beverage (if underage) as described in ORS 471.005.
- Motor vehicles are not allowed in the camping area. Except for move in/move out purposes.
- No animals or pets allowed in the campground.
- All campers are required to be in their camping unit and quiet one-half hour after the fair closes.
- Generators may be used between 7:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. only.
- Campfires, BBQ Grills, and Fire Pits are prohibited.
- Camping shall only be in tents, camper vans, RVs, camping trailers, or truck campers specifically designed by the manufacturer for sleeping and other normal camping uses. Camping in non-camping vehicles such as passenger cars, pickups, pickups with bed cover, and non-camper vans is prohibited.
- All fencing, gates, barriers, signage, and equipment that are part of the Campgrounds or campsites shall not be tampered with, disturbed, damaged, removed, vandalized, etc. This includes unbolting or cutting sections of perimeter fencing.
- Smoking/Vaping is prohibited in the entire Fairgrounds including the campground and individual campsites.
- All occupants must adhere to the Washington County Fair Board Weapons Policy.
- Camping is at your own risk. Washington County is not responsible for loss, theft, or damage. Fair Management does not assume responsibility for the health and safety of persons camping.
- Registered campground users will have access to the showers in the cloverleaf building, portable restrooms, and handwashing stations. Users must clean up after themselves and be respectful of the next user.
- Camping disputes are to be brought to, and settled by, the Fair Manager, or designee.
- All campers will be courteous to Fair staff, security personnel, and fellow campers
- Bicycles, Skateboards, Scooters, Rollerblades or similar equipment are prohibited in the campground and the Fairgrounds
- All campers are to abide by campground rules. Persons not following these rules will be removed from the camping area by security for the duration of the Fair.

REGISTRATION AGREEMENT

By registering for a camping space at the Washington County Fair, the person registering agrees that they have read and understand, and in consideration for being permitted to participate at this event, agree and consent to abide by the all policies, procedures, requirements, and rules listed in this document and/ or on the Fair's website and agree that all occupants list on this camping registration form is participating at their own risk and the Washington County Fair shall not be liable for any damages whatsoever. By registering, the person and all people listed as an occupant on this camping registration form agrees to hold harmless Washington County, the Washington County Fair, its officers, employees, and agents both privately and in their official capacity from any and all damages. The person registering, and all people listed as an occupant on this camping registration form also agrees that by registering, they understand that violation of any WCF policies, procedures, requirements, and rules listed in this document and/ or on the Fair's website may cause disciplinary action that may result, but not limited to, in expulsion, forfeiture of premiums, awards and auction proceeds as well as future participation at the WCF.
