The Washington County Fair Board met at the U. S. National Bank Building with all members present.

County Judge Harry Seabold was present relative to the Social Security status of fair employees. A representative - Mr. Schmidt of the State Department of the Social Security had checked over the payroll of the fair board since 1953 and had determined quite a sum of money would be owing since the time the County employees were covered. Judge Seabold agreed that the County would, under the circumstances pay the back balance without trying to recover from the employees, which met with the approval of the fair board.
