The Washington County Fair Board met at the Court House at 10:00 A. M. Wednesday, April 6, 1932, with members of the County Court including Judge Templeton, Commissioners Hiatt and Kerkman, and the executives of the county 4H Club, including Mrs. J. D. Selby of Garden Home, James L. Batchelder, Hillsboro Route 1, and R. Hornecker, Hillsboro Route 5, and Mrs. F. W. Connell.

The meeting was called for the purpose of hearing the executive committee of the 4H Club present their plan for a 4H Club Fair, which was as follows: An appropriation of \$600 be made to pay premiums only, and that the present fair grounds and buildings be used and that they would assume all financial responsibility and management, and clean up the grounds and buildings at the close of their fair, and that they were to have the exclusive management of the 4H Club Fair. They are also pledging themselves to give their strongest support to the Washington County Fair for the year 1933.

After discussion and approval by the County Judge and Commissioners it was moved by Hesse, and seconded by Banks, that their request be granted as stated above.
