A special meeting was called of the Fair Board, meeting at the U. S. National Bank, for the purpose of considering bids on printing the Premium Book for 1956. Information was presented by Clayton Nyberg that the Tri-City News of Sherwood would print the same — for the advertising they could secure.

The Hillsboro Argus were not interested in printing the book on the basis as in the past that the advertising received would pay for the printing, however, a representative or employee might be interested.

A bid was received from the News-Times of Forest Grove offering to print the book as in the past for the advertising they could obtain. After discussion motion was made by Nyberg, seconded by Abts and carried that the News-Times be awarded the bid.

It was decided that we retain the same department heads and that they be so notified and asked to make any suggested changes by the **mext** meeting of May 15th.

All members of the board were present.

The minutes of the last two meetings were read and approved.
