Consulation with the county commissioners disclosed that the court was willing to back the fair board in making necessary repairs. to Grange building

W.J.Enschede moved that the board order necessary lumber to floor building number 1 (Grange) and motion was seconded by R.G.Scott. Motion carried and work was ordered to continue at once.

The manager was authorized to negotiate with Chester Bates for the remainder of the flooring and cedar sills.
