The Board discussed the open class livestock exhibitors sleeping in the barns. Currently there is no Fair Board policy on the matter. The Board agreed to allow it this year and to set policy for next year. This policy will be stated in the 1983 premium book.

The Board reviewed the day's schedule of events. Colegrove suggested at least one Fair Board member should be present until the clerks are finished and the office is closed each night. He urged the Board to use the sign-in sheet in the office.

The Board reviewed specific task assignments for the fair.

The Board set a maximum of \$200 for refreshments for the Rodeo or Destruction Derby Committee. The Board asked Hesse to use her discretion if the committees should ask for funds. This was discussed early in the year with committee members, but no final agreement was made on amount needed to provide adequate refreshments.

Love and Swan volunteered to check cars on the grounds after 10 a.m. License numbers of cars in violation will be announced over the P.A. system; and if not moved in a reasonable amount of time, will be towed at owners expense.

Sprecher will escort Governor Atiyeh during his visit to the fair tomorrow. Chairman Colegrove will show merit rater Jiggs Fisk around the fairgrounds.

Because of the rainy weather, several loads of rock have been ordered to fill in mud holes. This is an unexpected expense.

The Cloverleaf Community Building dedication will be at 6 p.m. and will be moved inside the building because of rain. Colegrove will introduce the Fair Board and Commissioners. At 6:25 p.m. in Friendship Square the Fair Board and Director Hesse will present the Volunteer Appreciation Awards.

The Wenatchee Youth Circus will be arriving about 2 p.m. Love will help them get settled in the camping area. The Board reviewed the codes to use over the P.A. system for emergency first aid and medical services.

The Main Exhibit Building roof is leaking in the land products area. Hart's reptile commercial booth was misplaced for set-up and will have to be relocated. The Board volunteered to help Harts move their booth. The main event for Wednesday will be the Destruction Derby. Next Fair Board meeting will be Tuesday, August 11, at 10 a.m.
