Chairman Colegrove announced that the Wenatchee Youth Circus was unable to perform because of poor weather conditions. The Board discussed payment of expenses to the Circus. The Circus was very understanding of our position and of the poor weather conditions. The Board voted to give the Wenatchee Youth Circus \$300 for expenses.

Secretary Valerie Bentley is in the hospital; the Board agreed to send her flowers.

Director Hesse announced that Victor Atiyeh, Governor of Oregon, will be visiting the fairgrounds today. He will be handing out awards and visiting the Republican booth. Governor Atiyeh wants to meet the people and children. His schedule will be: Arrive 4 p.m., Republican booth 4:45 p.m., Destruction Derby 6:30 p.m., and leaving at 7:30 p.m.

State Merit Rater "Jiggs" Fisk will be on the fairgrounds all day today.

The grandstand entertainment for this evening is the Destruction Derby. Fair Board members will be needed to help watch the gates. John Love volunteered to help.

Hesse feels the gate people are doing a good job and security is also going well.

The Board discussed use of the Sheriff's Building as the Fair Board headquarters during fair. The north door cannot be opened with the keys. The first aid crew is using the room for restrooms and emergencies. The coke machine is also placed there.

Hesse asked the Board to write down all their comments and suggestions for the 1983 fair. The gate attendance and revenue are higher than expected considering the rain and the cancelled youth circus.

The Board discussed 4-H and FFA rules for cattle. The Board reviewed the Cloverleaf Community Building dedication. Chairman Colegrove did a great job of introducing everyone.

Dale Scheller has organized and is managing the booth set up for the promotion of the Hotel/Motel Tax. The booth is also helping to recruit volunteers to help with the campaign.
