WASHINGTON COUNTY FAIR BOARD Minutes of August 12, 1970

The regular monthly meeting of the Washington County Fair Board was held in the fair office on August 12, 1970 with Chairman Jossy presiding. Those present were Adams, McGough, Scott, Lindow, Ball and Shearer.

Mr. Jossy reported Sunset Grange, the first place winner in the Community Booths division, removed their exhibit at 5 p.m. on Saturday, August 8. Mr. Lindow moved to disqualify their exhibit, they must forfeit their premium and will not be allowed to exhibit at the 1971 State Fair. Mr. Adams seconded. Motion carried. It was agreed a letter stating this be sent to them and also to the Aloha Grange informing them.

The beer booth netted \$246.70 and it was agreed \$35.00 be donated to the sorority handling the man power.

Several problems concerning the rodeo and horse show were discussed. It was agreed to continue horse participation during the rodeo performances.

The Merit Rating Criteria booklet was filled in on the points.

The minutes of the premius meeting were read and approved as read.

A request by a Horse group had been received regarding use of the PA system in the arena. It was agreed to allow this usage. All the inter-com boxes and horns should be brought in.

New rate schedule for the arena was set as follows:

Horse Show - from \$20.00 to \$25.00
Jr. Horse Show - from \$10.00 to \$15.00
Horse Show with Admission charge - deleted
Roping - deleted
Jackpot roping - deleted
Jackpot roping - adm. charge - deleted
Use of concession stand from \$5.00 to \$10.00

If group asks that arena be worked and watered the charge will be \$25.00, waterede only \$15,00, worked only \$15.00. This to be added to the rental agreement.
