Tiz Walker has cleaned the restrooms during the fair for three years. Some of Mrs. Walker's concerns included, the placement of the air vents in the Cloverleaf Community Building restrooms, the overall condition of the Main Exhibit Building restrooms, and handicapped restroom facilities on the fairgrounds. Walker felt no improvements have been made in the last five years. Hesse pointed out several minor improvements have been made. The Board is aware of the poor conditions of the restrooms. Walker also suggested having a locker in each location to hold the necessary cleaning supplies and paper supplies. The Board asked Mrs. Walker to compile a written list of her concerns and thanked her for attending the meeting. The restrooms have been continually "fixed," but they need to be totally renovated.

The Thursday evening rodeo performance was comfortably full. There will be more cowboys competing in Friday's rodeo.

The north parking lot needs signs indicating fire lanes.

The Washington County Department of Finance & Administration has made a transfer to our government pool account of \$28,467.68 for the fairgrounds portion of the second quarter hotel/motel tax receipts.

The Rodeo Committee has invited the Fair Board to their barbeque tomorrow after the 1:30 matinee performance behind the stock pens. The Washington County Livestock Association steak fry is scheduled tonight from 4 to 7 p.m.

The maintenance crew is still working on the milk parlor drain. There also was a problem with the milk parlor generator, but that is under control.

The Board agreed that electrical switches for lights and switches for refrigeration should be marked different, so there would be no mix-ups.

Next Fair Board meeting will be Saturday, August 14, during the Washington County Fair beginning at 10 a.m.
