

August 26, 1936.

The Fair Board met in the Chamber rooms Wednesday night, August 26, with all members present, and President Hesse presiding.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved as read.

The manager made a report of the work which had been done, and of his plans for the program, etc.

A petition was presented from Mr. Chingren, president of the Oregon State Fairs Association, and asking for the signature of the Fair Board. This petition was to be presented to the Supreme Court of Oregon asking that the present law regarding racing be not recalled, and was duly signed by the Fair Board members.

Moved by Mr. Minton, seconded by Mr. Banks, that the premium on the insurance held by Mr. Walker be paid. Motion carried.

It was decided to have the same judges as last year if they were willing to serve.

Moved by Mr. Minton, seconded by Mr. Banks, that a warrant be drawn from the premium fund for \$40.00 in payment of the premium lists. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Minton, seconded by Mr. Banks, that the bill for the premium ribbons, entry tags, etc., in the amount of \$42.90, be drawn from the premium fund. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Minton, seconded by Mr. Banks, that a check be drawn for \$5.00 in payment of our membership in the Oregon Fair Secretaries Association. Motion carried.

On motion the meeting adjourned.
