TIME FRAME: Trucks to deliver gravel from Howell's (1 hour 15 min.) will start at 7:00 a.m. the weekend of August 18th. Areas will be spotted to deposit and stockpile gravel for the project. Each truck will make approximately four round trips.

Trenchers will start August 20th. Hopefully backhoes can come in to start and do water/gas line connection areas before trenchers move in. (Trenchers can work with backhoes working ahead.) Connection points (water/gas lines) and all lines must be spotted and hand dug if necessary. (Lines staked, laid out, string tile lines, gas/water lines cut, fences out.)

Tile will be placed, covered with earth 4" - 5" deep; a dump of gravel will be placed every 30' (approximate), then backfilled. The process should involve several weeks. Afterwhich the fairgrounds will be relandscaped and generally restored. The County will cover the SAIF insurance costs. The Fair Office wil keep records of all volunteers. The fairgrounds will have fuel available for the machinery. Follow-up letters will be sent to coordinate the project.
