

minutes - Washington County Fair Board - December 23, 1970

This special meeting of the Washington County Fair Board was held at Merrill's Coffee Shop on December 23, 1970 with Chairman Jossy presiding. Those present were McGough, Lindow, Shearer and guests Lyell Gardner and Bob Christensen.

Dr. McGough introduced Mr. Christensen to the Board. He is a member of the Christensen Brothers Rodeo Contractors. He stated they are very interested in putting on a show at the Washington County Fair under the auspices of RCA. The Board gave him the history of the rodeo performances and what the future plans for seating, etc. Mr. Christensen stated he would furnish the clowns, announcer, secretary, timers, stock, etc. The Fair Board would furnish the hay and pasture area. He felt there would be no problem with cowboys attending. The airport adjacent to the grounds would be an asset. A show with 5 events would cost \$5650. Jumping and barrel racing or any other events would be the board's responsibility.
