

FAIR BOARD MEETING.

The Washington County Fair Board met Dec. 9, 1938 in the Chamber of Commerce with President Banks, R. G. Scott, Leon S. Davis and Mrs. Davis present.

The annual Financial Report was presented by the secretary and a motion was made by Mr. Scott and seconded by Mr. Banks to approve said report for 1938 and send a copy to the County Court. Passed.

Moved by Mr. Scott and seconded by Mr. Banks to pay dues for 1937 and 1938 to Oregon County and District Fairs of \$5.00 per year. Passed.

Motion made by Mr. Scott and seconded by Mr. Banks to refuse bill of Miss Gene Beach for mileage presented to Mr. Kraus and through him to the Fair Board. Passed.

Motion made by Mr. Banks and seconded by Mr. Scott to allow overdraft of \$30.47 on premium funds and to repay same from bank balance. Passed.

Motion made by Mr. Scott and seconded by Mr. Banks authorizing manager, Leon S. Davis, to pay as much as possible on the bank loan from the funds in the dog racing fund in the treasurer's office. Passed.
