WASHINGTON COUNTY FAIR BOARD MEEDING.

TUESDAY EVENING, FEBRUARY 27, 1934.

Officers present - R. M. Banks, president; C. D. Minton, vice-president; H. T. Hesse, treasurer; and Ed. L. Moore, secretary.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

After considerable discussion, and receiving the statement from County Judge Don Templeton and the County Commissioners, that they would guarantee that the amount on hand at this date together with the receipts from the racing commission for 1934 would be \$1,000.00, it was moved by Minton, seconded by Hesse, that a Washington County Fair for 1934 be held, the date to be determined later. Motion carried.

It was moved by Minton, seconded by Hesse, that the Fair Board be paid \$3.00 per member for the eleven meetings of the Board held in 1931, 1932 and 1933, making \$33.00 per member. Motion carried, and checks were drawn for these amounts signed by the president and treasurer.

The secretary was instructed to prepare and submit a premium list, and to invite the heads of the Granges of Washington County to attend the next meeting.

Upon motion the meeting adjourned.
