

FAIR BOARD MEETING.

FRIDAY NIGHT, FEBRUARY 5, 1932.

A meeting of the Washington County Fair Board was held in the Chamber of Commerce rooms Friday night, February 5, 1932, with the following directors present: C. D. Minton, H. T. Hesse, and Ed. L. Moore.

The meeting was called for the purpose of considering a proposition from a committee from Pomona Grange including Bill Averill, A. B. Johnson and M. F. Mills, all of whom were present. This committee was appointed for the purpose of investigating in regard to a Grange and 4H club fair to be held in 1932. It was proposed and suggested that an entry fee be charged the 4H club members and granges sufficient to cover the expense of the Grange and 4H club fair.

This committee reported that they had investigated the insurance and had interviewed the County Court regarding the Fair. They said that the County Court stated that the matter was entirely in the hands of the Fair Board, but that the County Court would pay the insurance on the buildings and property amounting to possibly \$123.00

No definite plans were submitted, but a meeting of the Fair Board was called for Tuesday afternoon, February 9, at 1:30, to determine what plans should be used for a Fair by the Fair Board, and if a plan was adopted notice was to be sent Effie Dorland, secretary Pomona Grange, Hillsboro, R. 3.
