The Fair Board met at the office of the new fair grounds at 8:00 p.m., with all members present.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved as read.

Upon motion made by Abts and seconded by Nyberg and passed, the following bills were approved:

Electric bill - - - -	\$ 1.85 ✓
Railway Express charges on fair materials- - - - -	2.14 ✓
Total - - - -	<u>\$ 3.99</u>

The matter of funds to complete the buildings was discussed. Present were representatives of the Fair Movers committee and representatives from the Washington County Sheriff's Posse who agreed to accept the responsibility of putting on a horse show.

Various phases of the program were discussed - charges, etc, but no motion was entertained on this.

Relative to the horse show it was agreed that for this year it should be an open show from the county as entertainment only, with no charge.

There being no further business, upon motion made, seconded and carried, the meeting stood adjourned.
