## FAIR BOARD MEETING

## TUESDAY NIGHT, JULY 21, 1931

Members of the Board present: President Banks, 1st vice president Minton, second vice president Hesse, treasurer Kraus and Manager Moore. Others present were Mr. Averill, Mr. Cyrus, Mr. Wharton and Mr. Greer.

Minutes of last meeting read and approved.

Moved by Minton, seconded by Kraus, that Mr. Rushlow be allowed the extra \$3.00 on insurance. Motion carried.

Moved by Minton, seconded by Hesse, that an allowance be made of \$10.00 for postage and other office expense. Motion carried.

Secretary reported on the competitive drill teams of the different Granges. After discussing the amount of the prizes it was moved by Minton, seconded by Kraus, that the amount of the prizes offered be \$30 for 1st, \$20 for 2nd and \$10 for 3rd, with first, second and third ribbons. Motion carried.

General discussion was had regarding price of admission. Moved by Minton, seconded by Hesse, that the admission price be \$.25 day or night, with a season ticket for \$.75. Motion carried.

After discussion in regard to the bands for the Fair the matter was laid on the table until a future meeting.

It was moved by Minton, seconded by Hesse, that an appropriation of \$250 be made for fireworks. Motion carried.

Moved by Minton, seconded by Kraus, that an appropriation of \$225 by made for advertising. Motion carried.

Moved by Minton, seconded by Hesse, that an appropriation of \$400 be made for free entertainment in place of the rodeo. Motion carried.

Moved and seconded that the usual amount of appropriation be made for the community contests and community programs, and \$175 for a vaudeville and orchestra the night of September 12. Motion carried. (Minton-Hesse)

Moved by Minton, seconded by Kraus, that a special appropriation be made of \$5.00 for Pete Vanandenhaugen for whistling, placing the other competitive whistlers in the amateur class. Motion carried.

Moved by Minton, seconded by Kraus, that a home beautification club be added to our premium list. Motion carried.

Motion made by Minton, seconded by Hesse, that the secretary be authorized to secure ribbons and supplies for the Fair. Motion carried.

By motion the Board adjourned.
