Chairman John Thomas calls the meeting to order with the standard welcome to the audience.

1.Consent Agenda: Margaret Garza gives the report. Margaret goes over the financial position of May, 1998.

Chairman Thomas calls for a motion to accept the consent agenda, Lyle Spiesschaert so moves, Ken Leahy seconds, the motion passes.

2.Rodeo Report: Cody Feinauer gives the report. Things are going good, got the calf pens torn down. We were in the Rose Festival Starlight Parade with a float. Brought a "tape" for anyone that would want to see it. The rodeo board "poured" out the "Black Star" beer after a couple of sips. Cal suggest that if the beer is received that badly that we might want to consider not having a beer sponsor altogether. Something that we have to discuss further. Cody said he didn't like it either. Cody did talk to Terry

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Amato and told him about the reception on the beer, his reaction was, "oh no". Cody asks, if we have to go with this beer, do we have to give it to our sponsors? His concern that we ask folks for 15K for sponsorship and we give them an inferior beer. Cal mentions our only other possible alternative is Hamm's. Shelia Day asks if the beer stand that deals in Black Star is limited to only the rodeo grounds, Cal says no, that there are four stands on all the fairgrounds and they all will be serving the sponsor beer (Black Star). Sponsorship is for only 5K. Lyle asks about the lack of interested beer sponsors. Cal says that beer sponsorship is based on "pourage" and that beer drinking is down at festivals and events, and so is sponsorship. We were able to stay with Henry's longer than anyone else did. Now we are the last one to be dropped. A question was asked by Shelia Day as to when the first Washington County Fair took place. Cal says that it was in 1854, that 5 fairs started in the same year. That Yamhill was probably the first, will have Paige call Yamhill to confirm.

<u>3.Boosters Report:</u> Fred Scheller gives report. Have been getting the premium books out. Been working on membership, and been getting a good response. Are doing a monthly newsletter going out to 77 people, not all those people are members, but are friends of the fair. Are offering "vests" to our members, they can buy the vests for \$10. Cal mentioned that Paige has ordered fair caps. Parking for the air show, it's tough to get enough people to do the job.

4.4-H Horse Report: Bill Pederson gives the report. Cal and Bill got together on a budget issue, it's getting resolved. Mentions that he had talked to Denise Oster about her concern she had with fair security. Bill McKinley mentions a meeting scheduled tomorrow with Art Berry, Rick for Premier, Dan Puncochar, and Denise to speak to this incident of last year and to go over our security procedures. The horse advisory board is upset with the lack of progress on these stalls. We have lost over 30% of entries because of lack of facilities. The board wants an answer as to where we are going on this issue. Discussion about stalls. A consensus being that we need to have an answer by September.

<u>5.Fair Report:</u> Bill McKinley gives report. Been working very heavily with Air Show. Pepsi contract has been returned, signed. Going to meet with them in the next day or so. Will be lining up dispensing machines for boosters. Only have a few payments due for concession stands. Still have a couple of service groups to go to complete our need package this year. Talked to bob Friedman with "Research for Marketing" in doing an exit survey, suggest we treat RFM as a "single source" given our 1993 survey

and that they do virtually all the fair work in the region. Lyle asks if we asked about a non-attendee survey, Bill said he did, and they can do that.

Lyle moves that the board authorize Bill to enter into a contract with Research For Marketing to conduct an exit survey and a non attendee off site telephone survey, Shelia seconds, the motion passes.

6.Marketing Report: Margaret Garza gives report. Margaret passes out schedule of events for the month of June. Been working on the entertainment guide, many who signed on for advertising will be returning this year. Have also placed several new ads for this year, including two retirement centers. Cody Feinauer asks about a "junior barrel race function" coming this Saturday? Cody just heard rumor of such an event. Margaret says she knows of no such event. Bill Pederson says it must be a pre-fair function. Cody just does not want a conflict with his work parties scheduled for the next several weeks. Question related to Speedway's motorcycle events. Margaret related that in Robin Niccolaides contract he must return the arena to original condition or all future events are cancelled.

7.Maintenance Report: Mike Wold gives report. He mentions that the construction portion of the grandstand rebuild is finished. Getting ready for Air Show, maintenance complemented for their efforts, even their extra efforts. Cal mentions because of the inability of the crew to take any time in the month of July for personal or vacation that he allows the staff one paid day at 4th of July as a compensation. Will allow staff to take off either Thursday or Monday since the 4th falls on a Saturday this year. Lyle asks if it's OK to do this. Cal says, they do, as a fair board. Margaret says that we make sure that someone is here on both Thursday and Monday. We put new locks on the livestock restrooms because of the vandalism that has taken place.
