The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gardner at 8:00 p.m.

Mr. Dave Luethe and Bud Douthit, representing a local motorcycle club met with the board to discuss the possibility of haveing a motorcycle race, Saturday night, August 20 at 9:30 ap.m. The Fair Board would have the concessions and receive 5% of the gate. The Club would be responsible for policing, handling the gate, the cleanup and insurance. Mr. Luethe stated he would take this information back to his group and would keep in touch with the board.

Mr. Ned Holden, Jim Phillips, and Steve White met with the board to answer the letter written to the Boy Scoutsin regard to the mess they left the grounds in after their Scoutarama. They stated they were surprised at the lack of facilities in a county this size but were able to organie and make do. They expressed their apologies for all the misunderstandings that arese from this and are willing to do anything that will put them in good light of the Fair Board. The Board accepted their apologies and felt communications had fallen down between the two parties. Mr. Holden said they would like to use the grounds again in 1968 sometime in the second or third week of April. He also stated the Boy Scouts have access to fir trees and would plant some on the fairgrounds as a porject whenever plans are definite.

Mr. Pat Gordon of Kozlovske Associates and Mr. Bob McDougall of the County Planners, met with the board to discuss plans and offer proposals for the grounds. Mr. Gordon stated the county planners could present a very complete preliminary study of the needs and desires of the Board which would give his company a good basis for doing the proposed plan no. 3. (Copy attached). The Board thanked them for coming to the meeting and will discuss this further and get in touch with them.

The Secretary received a request fro the use of the track for an Auto Cross by a local club. They wanted it for June 19 or July 10 and would like a reduced rate since this is just for their own club. Mr. M Jossy made a motion to allow this use but not at a reduced rate. The rent to stay at \$50.00. Dr. McGough seconded. Motion carried.

Portland General Electric contacted Mrs. Ball stating that the meter at the track still is in Kartway's name and the should be disconnected or the name changed to the Fair. The Board asked Mr. Thomas to call PGE and make the necessary arrangements.

A resolution regarding the budget accounts was presented to the board by the Secretary. Mr. Lindowmade amotion to pass this resolution. Mr. Jossy seconded. Motion carried. A copy of this resolution is attached. The second copy is in the budget file.

Mr. Thomas reported on the program and the booth sales.

Dr. McGough moved to build, with this priority, box stalls, flower shed by fair time and rodeo grounds ready by Labor Day so that a rodeo could be put on September 4 and 5. Mr. Weible seconded. Motion carried.

The question came up regarding donations and if they are tax deductible by private individuals. (The secretary called the CPA, June 2, he stated kikk this is deductible and that a receipt be made out by the Fair Board and read "Denation.")

The next open budget meeting will be June 14, 1966 at 1:30 P.M. This is the Board of County Commissioners' hearing on the budget.

The secretary wasordered to write aletter to the Washington County Riders Association, c/o Charles O. Davis, 290h 26th, Forest Grove, to the effect that the Fa,r Board will start construction of the rodeo grounds and as soon as preliminary work is completed, will be ready for fencinego
