The Washington County Fair Board met in the conference room of the County Extension Department in the Court House with Al. Lindow presiding since president— Sahnow was absent. Tony Abts was also present and Ed. Ball absent.

Nina Greenslade was present asking if the 4-H department might not do some of the judging on the clothing prior to the opening of the fair, due to inability to get judges during the week. They were granted this priviledge.

Lloyd Junken and others were present representing the county Sheriff's Reserve asking if it might be possible that this group to have a building as a permanent meeting place for them and if the fair board would consider buying the material if their representatives would build it. They would like something with a cement floor, water lights, etc, the size to be about 20' x 40'. The fair board asked that they see just what they could do towards raising funds to help out and get an estimate of the construction, and it could be further discussed at a later date.

Hilda Highbe representing the 4-H eating concession was present asking if the fair board was ready to build a cement slab so that their building might be moved and constructed in a permanent location. The board assured her this would be done when they were ready. (It was to be 34' x 34')

Harris H. Hansen, Jr., was also present relative to working as assistant manager, advertising manager and general assistant. After discussing the situation with him motion was made by Mr. Abts, seconded by Mary Hadley that we hire Mr. Hansen as assistant manager to start June 1st, at the rate of \$250.00 per month, plus necessary mileage connected with fair activities. Motion carried.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.
