Chairman John Thomas calls the meeting to order with the standard welcome to the audience.

1. Consent Agenda: Margaret Garza gives the report. Margaret goes over the financial position of April 1998.

<u>Chairman Thomas calls for a motion to accept the consent agenda, Sheila Day so moves, Dave Lintz seconds, the motion passes.</u>

2. Rodeo Report: Cody Feinauer gives the report. Things are going "good". Apologies for press release that did not mentioned the Fair.

Cody mentions that lack of time is a problem insofar as the "grand entry" and introducing all the dignitaries that should be recognized. He suggests that the grand entry start about ten minutes to 7:00 PM so that can be accomplished before the official start of the rodeo. Cal mentions that he cannot see a problem in making the additional time available. Gary McVey has questions. Are RV contractors going to be allowed to park in the area normally reserved for rodeo personnel. Cal states that the contractors will not be there, Bull fighting sponsor wants to know if the new light rail will transport before the official opening of the line. Cal and Margaret says they will attempt to motivate MAX to start up between Hillsboro and Fair early. Sheila Day mentions about the queen application documents do not have a return address on the letter or who even wrote the letter. Cody makes note.

- 4. Boosters Report: Fred Scheller gives report. Premium books are almost all delivered. Having a fine reception in the venues where they were taken. The boosters vests will be worn during the fair. Working on getting the booth ready. Working on getting people for the air show.
- 5. 4-H Horse Report: Bill Peterson gives report. We do have a night watchman. Fair plans are moving right along.
- 6. Fair Report: Bill McKinley gives report. We have a new soft drink provider, Pepsi-Cola will be our contractor for the next three years. We have an improved sponsorship position, plus an improved distribution ride. Fred Schellor asks about new machines in the boosters area. Cal says that we allow them to service all our interim contractors. Entertainment in place. Contractors with minor exception are in place.

Cal mentions that this project had to be deemed an emergency project with an expedited time line on completion. The low bidder was 45K, second was 52K and the third bid was over 60K. Gene Zurbrugg was the awarded contractor. Earl did a lot of work in cleaning up the bidding language. Apples and oranges. Plan on another \$3500 to \$4000 after the engineering, permits and everything else that is "required" to complete the project. Will come close to 50K with a 5K deductible. The insurance company is onboard to carry the 45K. Grandstand has been sandblasted, torn off all the damaged wood and are starting to rebuild it right now. Completion scheduled by the first of the month (June). David Lintz asks if there is more information on the fire report. Cal says that we know for sure that it was set, but how and why, nobody knows.

Dear Mr. Puncochar,

Cal Wade asked me to convey the Fair Board decision in regard to your letter of May 4. On May 6<sup>th</sup> the regularly scheduled meeting of the Washington County Fair Board reviewed your letter related to the concerns of Denese' Oster.

Naturally, the Board shares the alarm and seriousness of the incident described by Ms. Oster. The Fair has always addressed, as priority one, those concerns that deal with the safety, welfare and comfort of our Fair guests. The Board does not, however, feel that the use of signage on the grounds, or at the entrance gates to put a potential offender on notice is a prudent alternative. The Fair already has security procedures in place that should address any incident similar to the one Ms. Oster experienced. We intend to enforce those procedures, especially when notified, with the objective of protecting the public and enhancing the safe public image that the Fair has been noted for over the years.

Further, we are in concert with the 4-H Leaders Association in advising individuals of behavior that is unacceptable or violates existing policies or statutes. Those individuals that do not conform to acceptable standards at the Fairgrounds will be dealt with in the most expedient and appropriate manner.

As you are aware, we value the "family" atmosphere we have taken great pains to foster at the Washington County Fair. We know the general public, by in large, feel "safe" at the Fair. We intend for that tradition to continue. Thank you for your concern on behalf of Ms. Oster and all Fair patrons.
