

June 5, 1956

The Washington County Fair Board met in the lounge room of the United States National Bank, with all members present, at 8:30 p.m.

A Mr. Sears, Peterson and Johnson, members of the State Horseshoe Pitchers Association were present relative to an understanding or agreement as to prizes for their annual playoff conducted during the fair.

Motion was made by Abts, seconded by Sahnaw and carried that \$100.00 be granted the Horseshoe Pitchers Ass'n with which to purchase their trophies, prizes, etc.

Mr. Alton Smedstad was present relative to the assistant managership of the 1956 fair. After discussing the particulars of such position Mr. Smedstad agreed to accept according to the following motion--

Motion made by Abts that the fair board hire Mr. Smedstad for the position of assistant manager for the fair season of 1956 consisting of the months of July and August at a salary of \$500.00 to be divided between July and August, plus mileage @ 7¢ per mile. Motion was seconded by Nyberg and carried.

The previous minutes were read and approved with the following correction or clarification as to the sixth paragraph in the minutes of May 15, - that the \$100.00 expense now accepted on the swine barn was to be a part of the \$350.00 later referred to in that paragraph, as might be the difference between the amount the swine breeders would raise as contributions and the amount the fair board would accept as their responsibility towards such building.

Motion was made by Nyberg, seconded by Abts and carried that the following bills be allowed, however, any bill pertaining to the building of the swine barn be held up until okeyed by a member of the swine breeders.
