

Fairgrounds
June 5, 1961

The meeting was called to order by the President at 8:35 P.M.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved as read.

Mr. Class of the Oregon Electric Railway Historical Society Inc. met with the board to discuss moving the streetcar to their museum at Glenwood. The board informed him that the Fair Board had nothing to do with the car except that it was on the Fairground property. He stated if the Board would give him a letter of title he would move the car by the first of July. This will be done and Mr. Abts will see the District Attorney to get the proper wording which would free the Fair Board of any obligation.

Tickets for the Square Dance Jamboree was discussed. They would be given tickets for pre-dance sale as soon as this could be arranged.

Mr. Graves from Kartway met with the board to see what could be done to get a road into the race tract from Cornell. They are to have a district meet July 7, 8, and 9 and would like the road completed at that time. The board agreed this would be possible and would start working on this. Mr. Graves asked about changing the wording in their lease to read that children under 16 ^{could} drive in the races. Also, that they would have a junior class of 12-16 year olds. Mr. Lindow advised him to see the county court in regard to this and stated the Fair Board had no objections.

Since Mr. Christensen has made no move to get off the fairgrounds, the secretary was ordered to write him advising him he must move by July 15.

The amount of money actually paid to the Horse Association was discussed. After looking through the previous years ledgers, it was discovered \$100.00 was paid in 1966 and \$120.00 paid in 1957. The 1958 check for \$100.00 was made in November of 1959 but was never paid to the Association.

The Secretary reported she had contacted Mr. Harry Elliott in regard to wrestling at the fair. Mr. Elliott was certain this could be arranged and would write confirmation in the near future.
