

FAIR BOARD MEETING.
Mar. 16, 1939.

The Washington County Fair Board met Mar. 16, 1939 in the Chamber of Commerce with Board members, R.G.Scott, W.J. Enschede and Harry Schmeltzer as well as manager Leon S. Davis and Mrs. Davis, present. Supervisors McDonald, Vincent and Treglown and Mr. Torvend, 4H Dept. and Mr. Blinkhorn of F.F.A were also in attendance.

Election of officers for the board was held with Mr. Enschede nomination R.G.Scott to the presidency of the board for the coming year and he was unanimously elected. Mr. Enschede was elected vice president and Mr. Schmeltzer treasurer.

The Bangs test for cattle , exhibited at the Fair, was discussed and upon consulting Dr. Bean, it was found there must be 2 tests not more than 12 months apart nor less than 8 months.

It was moved, seconded and passed to set the dates for the Washington County Fair as August 31, Sept. 1 and Sept. 2, 1939.

Some time was spent in going over the premium list with the superintendent of each department with a number of changes being made in same.

Motion was made by Enschede and seconded by Schmeltzer to include the utility bird in the poultry exhibit and premiums. Passed.

Motion made and seconded to eliminate paid superintendent and premium money in flower exhibit and turn the exhibit over to the 4H garden clubs to handle for both the open exhibit and the 4H exhibit. Passed. Mr. Enschede then offered a first class rose bush to each 4H blue ribbon winner in the flower exhibit.

Harry Schmeltzer was appointed to take charge of the Farm Crop and Vegetable exhibit at the Fair.
