

March 21, 1950

Washington County Fair Board met March 20, 1950 in the office of the manager with all members present including manager and secretary.

Manager announced Mr. Guerber had been reappointed to the Fair Board for another 3 year term.

Election of officers was held. Mr. Abts nominated Harry Schmeltzer for president to which office he was duly elected. Mr. Schmeltzer nominated Mr. Abts for vice president and he was elected unanimously. Mr. Schmeltzer nominated Mr. Guerber as treasurer to which office he was unanimously elected.

Mr. Schmeltzer nominated Mrs. Davis as secretary, seconded by Mr. Guerber and passed.

Mr. Guerber then moved to hire Mr. Davis as manager of the Fair at the same salary as last year, seconded by Mr. Schmeltzer and passed unanimously.

Mr. Davis presented a bill for entertaining several department heads and the president of the Booster association at the Oregon Fair Convention amounting to \$20.00. Mr. Schmeltzer moved to allow this bill, seconded by Mr. Guerber and passed.

Mr. Guerber moved to charge 50¢ admission to the Fair this year, seconded by Mr. Abts and passed.

In an effort to raise money for Fair purposes Mr. Guerber moved to hold a Queen contest this year in connection with the Fair. Mr. Schmeltzer seconded the motion which passed unanimously.
