Washington County Fair Board met in the office of the manager with all members present including the manager and secretary. J.B. Thomas, F.F.A. superintendent and Joe Cox assistant county agent were present to present changes in their part of the premium list.

Secretary read a letter from Lincoln Wheeler, manager Land Products show of the Pacific International to Judge Kerkman, inquiring whether or not Washington County would have a booth at the exposition in 1948. After discussion Mr. Guerber moved to put up \$400 for P.I. booth, including the \$200 premium money, providing it is matched with \$400 from another source. seconded and passed.

Transportation for 4-H livestock to Salem 1947 state fair presented by assistant county agent, Mr. Cox. An allowance of \$60 being in the premium book annually, it was voted to pay the extra \$25 thereby paying the total bill of \$85.

Mr. Cox presented his corrections and changes for the 1948 premium book. All were carefully discussed individually after which Mr. Guerber moved to allow the changes for 4-H as per the attached copy. Seconded by Mr. Schmeltzer and passed.

Mr. Thomas then presented his requests for the F.F.A. part of the premium book, which were gone over by the board and upon motion of Mr. Schmeltzer and second of Mr. Guerber were passed as per the attached list.

Motion made to adjourn.
