

May 11, 1954

A special meeting was called of the fair board at the Commercial Bank of Oregon, with all members present.

The main purpose of the meeting was to get together an estimate of the building of a garden exhibit space together with a club room for a meeting place for various clubs to be used during the year.

Herb Mohr, local contractor and builder presented an estimate on the plan drawn by Garden Club members of \$16,943.55, board and batten 95x 150 feet for garden exhibit space only.

The Club Room division dimensions of 50 x 95' with floor and ceiled would be estimated to run around \$3.00 per square foot, and this would not be taking into account any donations. This room was to have a kitchen and rest room facilities.

After some discussion, and Mrs. Arthur Fisher, publicity of Garden Clubs drive for funds, being present, it was thought that a part of the building might be constructed and later additions made, but no definite decision was made, as representatives of other clubs representing interest in the Club room would be present at the next meeting May 18.

J. B. Thomas, Future Farmer advisor asked for a few changes in that department to be placed in the premium book.

The matter of prize money for the State Horseshoe pitching tournament was discussed and it was moved by Abts, seconded by Sahnaw that we give trophies only, which would be 12, and if the horseshoe pitchers representatives wished to set new pegs and improve the court themselves they might do so. Motion carried and the secretary was instructed to so notify them.

It was moved by Sahnaw and seconded by Abts that shavings be used entirely for the barns and that they be furnished by the fair board. Motion carried.

The minutes of the last two meetings were read and approved.
