Mrs. Donald Becker, president of the Veterans of Foreign Wars stated if the building did not take place that the \$50. donated by their organization be used for some other good purpose and that they be informed of such use.

Representatives from the Coffee Club were present asking for space at the fair for an eating concession- Mrs. Ed. Arnold and Mrs. Eilfs representing that group.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

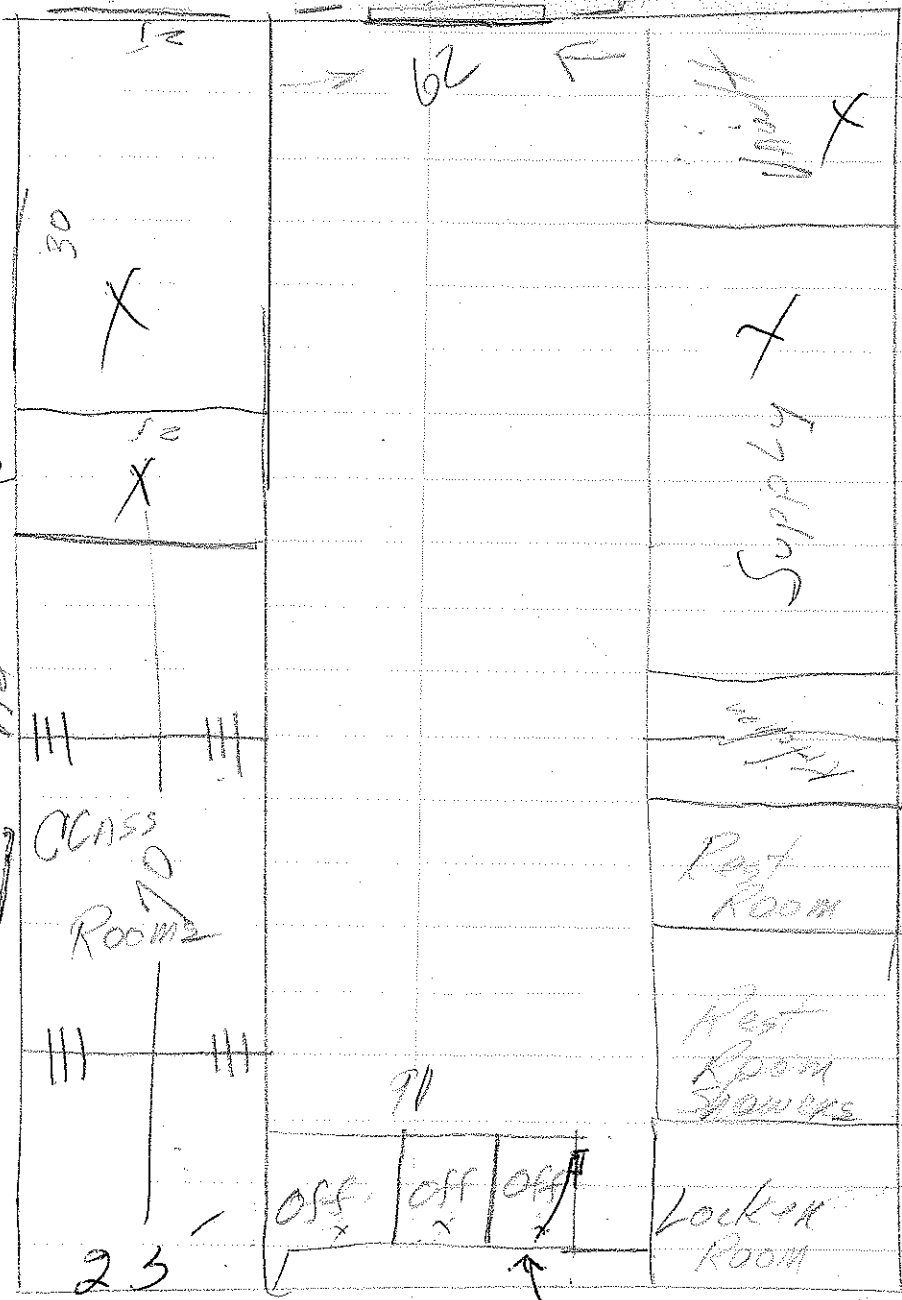
Motion carried.
