Washington County Fair Board met in the office of the manager with Mr. Guerber, Mr. Abts and Mr. and Mrs. Davis in attendance.

Letter from State Horseshoe pitching Association to the manager inviting him to attend a meeting in Portland May 29 and 30th for the purpose of discussing the possibility of holding the State contest at the Fair this year. Mr. Guerber moved the manager discuss the state contest with the Horseshoe Pitching Association and invite them to hold it in Hillsboro during the Fair after arranging satisfactory terms, leaving the making of said terms to the manager. Seconded by Mr. Abts and passed.

The purchase of an air compressor for paint guns was discussed and Mr. Guerber moved the manager be authorized to purchase one for use at the Fair. Seconded by Abts and passed.

Manager reported writing the Redwood Shows regarding their Liability insurance. They answered they have insurance with Lloyds of London for \$50,000. This being satisfactory the contracts were signed.

Mr. Abts reported Ed Wortman was interested in buying the hay crop on the new Fair grounds. The Board authorized Mr. Abts to deal with Mr. Wortman for the sale of the hay.
