This special meeting of the ashington County Fair Board was held at merrill's Coffee Shop on movember 12, 1970 with Chairman Jossy presiding. Those present were mcGough, Lindow, Ball, Adams, Boott and Shearer.

This meeting was called to discuss further the barn or barns to be built for the horse stalls. It was agreed one larger barn would be better than two small barns considering the advantages of storage space, etc. 40' plus 6' overhand, 106' long would cost \$5900 not including stalls, wiring, etc. Going to a 48' wide building would give more room for storage without the cost being much greater and would work out for box stalls when and if these were added at a later date. More figures on a 48' wide building would be obtained and er. Kay would be given the go-shead on building.

Airstream trailer rally. They plan on 70 to 100 trailers and would want the southend of the pain Exhibit building for meetings. They would require no lights, some water and some restroom facilities as most of the trailers are self-contained. They have been paying \$65 to \$75 at other fairgrounds for the three day use. It was agreed the minimum rental would have to be \$125.00. Par. Jossy will discuss this further with the Association.

Fig. Adams is working on the possibility of starting a trust fund for a covered arena. He felt there are many 4-H groups in the county that would donate money for this and it could be worked into a project for anyone to donate.
