

November 28, 1949.

Washington County Fair Board met in the office of the manager with all members present.

Board discussed hiring of judges for future Fairs. Also discussed holding the Dairy show in 1950 and decided to discuss same with dairy people and county court at a later date.

Manager reported the Hillsboro F.F.A. would build a trailer for the Fair if Fair furnished the material. As the amount paid in rent for a trailer each year is almost as much as cost of the material, Mr. Schmeltzer moved manager purchase necessary materials for building trailer to be permanent property of Fair. Seconded by Mrs. Davis and passed.

Mr. Guerber moved to pay Mrs. Davis \$600.00 for secretarial and bookkeeping work for year 1949. Seconded by Mr. Schmeltzer and passed.
