The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

A letter from Gale Grange was read which was relative to planting trees on the fair grounds. It was agreed to accept their offer of planting and donating trees and the secretary was instructed to write them to this effect and asking that they start on the north side of the grounds next to the county road and continuing in line with those already planted about the same distance apart, continuing thence easterly as far as they wished.
