The Washington County Fair Board met at the Commercial Bank of Oregon with all members present.

Red Wilson and Walt Ruecker were present representing interest in leasing the race track at the fair grounds for the purpose of holding car races during the year. A contract was presented but was held up for further study.

Representatives of the Washington Grange were present to make settlement for their eating concession at the fair. They stated they did not derive much income from this - this year and after discussion it was agreed to settle with them for the sum of \$25.00.

It was agreed and motion was made by A. H. Abts and seconded by Merton Sahnow, and carried, that we pay Elmer E. Guerber \$1500.00 on loan made by him to the Washington County Fair, togehter with interest in the amount of \$80.00 (to Dec. 1. 1954), this leaving a balance on principal owing him of \$500.00. The Secretary was instructed to write him a letter asking if this would be satisfactory with him.

A resolution was passed as follows "Be It Resolved, That the President and Secretary are hereby authorized by the Washington County Fair Board to borrow up to the sum of Thirteen Thousand (\$13,000.00) Dollars - - - - without further action of the Fair Board, if it becomes necessary to repay any loan now in existence, or to meet further legitimate necessities. "

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved as read.

Mention was made of the Oregon Fairs Convention to be held in Portland at the Multnomah Hotel November 29, 30 and December 1, 1954.

The following bills were presented and upon motion by Sahnow and second by Abts and carried, were allowed:
