The meeting was called to order by President Lindow at 8:30.

The audit report of 1960-61 was present and the board reveiwed and discussed the recommendation made by the auditors. The board agreed that these would be complied with in every way possible.

A letter of John Lulich was read . The letter stated how much he and his family had enjoyed the superior quality of the fair.

Mr. Abts had been approached at the bank to honor several old premium checks from other years. The board stated premium checks will be honored only from the previous year. Any checks dating more than one year will be voidec.

Mrs. Edith Brodgen Stewart has offered to donate on ald threshing machine to the Fair Board. With this added equipment it was agreed that an old fashinned threshing bee might be a good attraction during the fair next year. Some grain will be planted in a specified area and others with old threshing machines will be invited. Mr. Abts made a motion that the Board accept this machine and Mr. Simantel seconded. Motion carried.

Mrs. Harry Bartlet of the Forest Grove garden club had asked Mr. Abts if they could get the \$112.00 from the savings account that they had donated for a floral building. They stated they wold like to buy new folding tables for the fair. The secretary was advised to write Mrs. Bartlett requesting her to contact Mr. Abtx at the bank to obtain the money.

The board asked that Mr. Abts see the County Court in regard to obtaining rock for the Kartway road so that it would be made more accesible during the winter months.
