There was an error in the budget. The \$5000.00 to be loaned did not have to be put in the budget because it was borrowed and repaid during the same year.

Mr. Abts made a motion that this be accepted as corrected and Mr. Simantel seconded. and the motion was carried.

The expense bill for Harris Hansen was presented to the board the the amount of 7ϕ a mile was paid.

The letter from the State Fire Marshall was read which stated certain improvements be made in the wiring. Thux Mr. Ball agreed this would be corrected before the 1962 fair.
