All contracts and plans for the square sets, the wrestling program and fund raising projects that the fair board had in mind will be temporarily tabled until such time as a clearly defined arrangements can be agreed upon by all concerned.

As there was no further discussion, meeting was adjourned at 10:55 P.M.
