Meeting called to order at 8:15 P.M.

Lloyd Juncken and Frank Bertalot of the Sheriff's Reserve met with the Board to suggest some possible changes to be considered by the Board in planning next year's Fair:

- a. That there be a specified bed time for the Four-Heers, so that there will be a limit to the time they run wild, and also that they not be allowed to sleep in the barns, as there is a possibility of someone being hurt by one of the animals.
- b. That loading and unloading of stock be done just outside of the gate with the aid of a ramp to prevent animals from being loaded before the 10:00 P.M. closing time.
- c. That all Four-H passes be admitted only through an accepted ticket gate, not through fences, etc.

Mrs. Jacobsen and Mrs. Falk of the Home Economics and Textile Departments met with the Board to suggest omitting some of this year's entries from next year's Premium Book, and adding others. It was also hoped that some of the premium prices could be raised. No decision made, but a reasonable chance of doing it to some extent next year.

The attached accounts payable were approved on a motion made by Tony Abts, seconded by Al Lindow and carried.

The attached premium changes in the F. F. A. section of this year's Premium Book were approved on a motion made by Tony Abts, seconded by Al Lindow, and carried.

The request by Kathleen Brown to refund her \$10.00 deposit was approved on a motion by Tony Abts, seconded by Al Lindow, and carried.

Approval of a safety deposit box for all Fair Board contracts and leases and all important papers was approved by a motion made by Al Lindow, seconded by Tony Abts, and carried.

Approval of the \$100.00 fee for the Water Show as submitted was approved

on a motion made by Tony Abts, seconded by Al Lindow. The Secretary was instructed to contact Lance Mooshaw to make arrangements for next year; and prepare for a bigger and better show well in advance of the Fair.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved on a motion made by Tony Abts, seconded by Al Lindow and carried.

After due consideration and discussion, it was agreed that \$1.00 per hour for each of the 300 free hours submitted by members of the Sheriff's Reserve during the Fair be given to the Reserve toward a drawing fund for the start of their building, which they have been most anxious to start for the past two years.




