CORRESPONDENCE PORT OF PORTLAND Koch, Sax, Rose, and Breedlove, Architects & Engineers wrote a letter advising the Fair Board that the Port of Portland has employed them to design relocation of Cornell Road and an office - restaurant - lounge building at the Airport. The Firm offered their service to the Fair Board. The Board is not interested at this time.

Mr. Jossy will send a letter to the Port of Portland indicating the willingness of the Fair Board to meet with Port officials. A copy of the letter from Koch, Sax, Rose and Breedlove will be sent to the County Commissioners as well as Port officials.

DIRECTOR OF EXTENSION

Director of Extension Service for the State of Oregon, GERVICE - STATE OF ORE Mr. Joe Cox sent a letter of appreciation for tickets sent to him and complimented the Board on vast improvements in the Fair he noted.

HILLSBORO JACYEES

A delgation from the Hillsboro Jacyees attended the Board meeting to discuss renting the Fairgrounds for their 4th of July Happy Days Celebration 1974. Discussion was opened by Mr. Adams on the possibility of combining Fair and Happy Days. Some conclusions reached after the discussion included: Two different types of crowds attended the events, Duplication of events must be kept to minimum or eradicated completely, Concerns were voiced about reigning courts and Miss Happy Days contest, Fair Board does not want the Jacyees getting into the Fair business, and finally help from the Jacyees in Fair promotion would be desireable.

1973 ADVERTISEMENT

Parallelism in the 1972 and 1973 ad program were discussed by the Board. Differences were also noted. Mr. Jossy advised the Board that Pepsi Day has brought an increase of 20% in paid gate and that manning gates longer hours seemed to pay its way. Fencing was also discussed and was termed helpful in crowd control. Bill boards were attractive and generally well accepted. Some difficulty was noted in getting news releases in local papers.

Mr. Ball was asked to get bids to have repairs made and the Board will review them through a telephone call as the building needs immediate attention.

AREA OFA MEETING

Mr. Jossy headed an Area meeting for Areas 1, 2 & 5. in Salem on August 30, 1973. Ed Ball, Joe VanDyke, and Addy Hesse attended for Mashington County. Fair problems were discussed and 1973 Fairs reviewed.

BORROWING FUNDS

The Cash flow indicated that borrowed funds will be needed by October 1 or sooner. It was discussed and understood that the guarantees signed by the fair board were still in the file at the bank and could be used to back the loan.

MOTION. HOVED BY JIH SPRINGER, SECONDED BY JOE VANDYKE TO BORROW FROM THE CAPITAL FUND AS HEEDED. MOTION CARRIED.

ADJOURNMENT

Mr. Adams dismissed the meeting at 11:55 p.m. Special meeting will be set up and Board members to be notified.
