

> Plant flowers and/or decorate a half whiskey barrel that will be provided by the fairboard. The whiskey barrels will then be placed around the fairgrounds for all spectators to enjoy.
(Placement will be made according to your request for full sunlight, part or full shade.)
DETAILS FROM THE FAIR BOOK:

1. Barrels are available for pickup after April 1 if you choose to transport the entire barrel. You may also purchase or borrow a 7 inch liner that fits in the whiskey barrel from the fairboard, making transportation much easier. If you purchase the liner, you may take your display home with you after the fair. If you choose to borrow a liner or plant the barrel, they are on loan and will be retained as fairboard property after the fair.
2. You may plant the barrel or liner anytime after April and may use them around your home or business until the fair. The barrels and/or liners must be delivered to the fair grounds on Friday between Noon and 8:00 pm along with an entry form from the fair website.
3. A panel of three judges will judge the barrels on Saturday morning. Ribbons will be awarded along with $\$ 100$ for first place, $\$ 50$ for second, and $\$ 25$ for third place. The top three will have bragging rights until the next fair and winners will be announced during evening activities.
