

JULY 4TH PARADE ENTRY FORM

The City of Waxahachie Annual Fourth of July Parade will take place on Tuesday, July 4, 2023. The parade will step off at 10 a.m. at Getzendaner Park. It will proceed north on Grand, right (east) on Main Street (U.S. Hwy. 287 Bus.), right (south) on Rogers Street, and end at the historic train depot for disbursement.

To participate in this year's parade, complete the form below and return to the Waxahachie Convention & Visitors Bureau, 2000 Civic Center Lane, Waxahachie, TX 75165, by noon, Monday, June 26, 2023.

Rules and regulations: The parade committee has the right to reject any entry that, in their opinion, is not appropriate. Marching members must be 10 years of age or older to march in the parade. Younger members will be required to ride on or in a vehicle or float. All entries MUST be appropriately decorated for July 4th.

Specialty or promotional items, including candy, flags, and magnets, ARE NOT allowed to be thrown from any vehicle or float. Items can, however, be handed out. DO NOT return to beginning of parade down Main Street going against parade entries!!! NO 18 WHEELERS ALLOWED!

Entries should be at Getzendaner Park by 9 a.m. to be judged. All equestrian units will be placed at the back of the parade – no exceptions and must provide a manure catcher for their entry.
