Section 8 Pigeons

- No specimen is to be handled by anyone except the owner, the judges, or members of the fair management unless permission is granted by the owner.
- Young specimens shall not be considered eligible for competition unless they have reached two-thirds mature development.
- Exhibitors' names or markings shall not be placed on the display coops prior to judging. After awards are made, advertising suitable to the management may be placed on cages.
- It is very important that each bird is banded with some type of band. Any bird not showing some type of band will not be judged and will automatically be ineligible for any award.
- All young birds must be banded with a seamless recognized band of the current year. SPECIAL NOTE: When cooping in your birds, be sure to MARK BAND NUMBERS ON COOP TAG FOR EACH BIRD.
- Any contingency that may arise and is not covered by these rules will be adjusted by the Superintendent whose action will be final.
- Pigeons will be shown individually.
